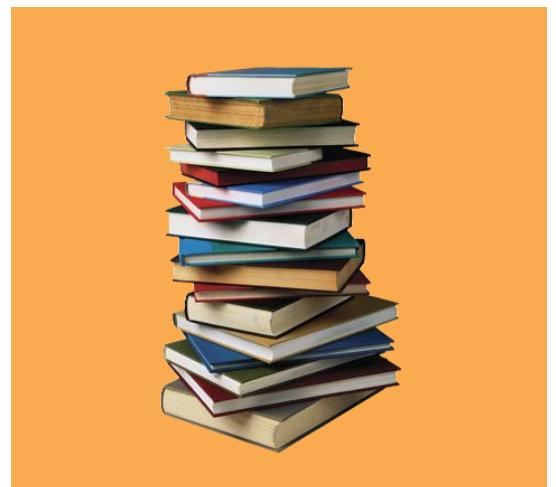

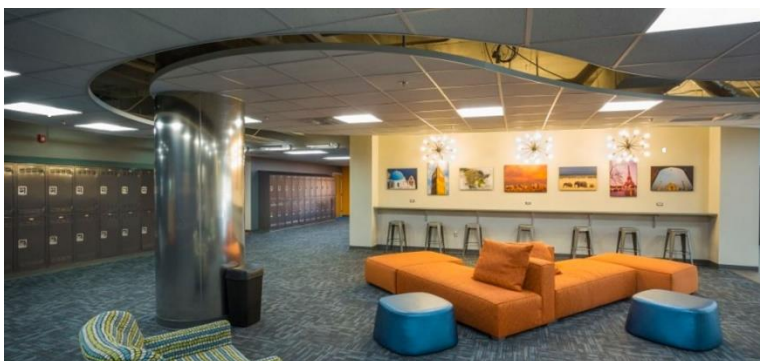

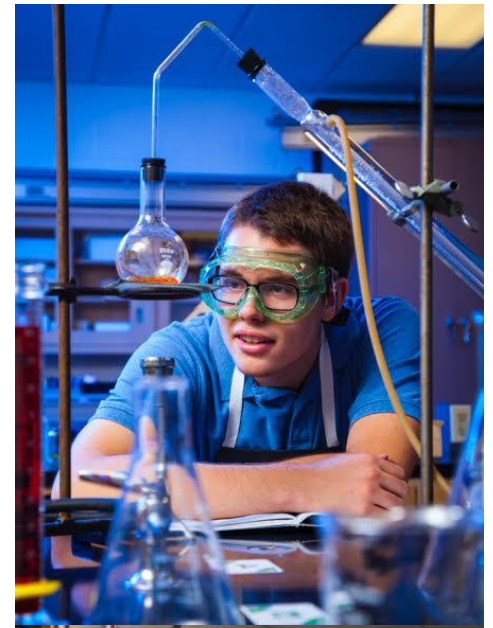

Spencerville Adventist Academy



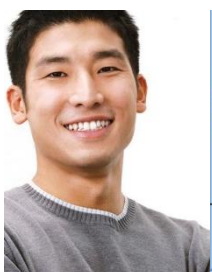

Unmanned Aviation Stem Program

A College Credit Plus (CCP) program approved by the Ohio Department of Education. High school students enrolled in the program can now earn credit towards both high school and college graduation requirements as well as industry certifications in the fast-growing UAS industry. In partnership with the Ohio Department of Education, the Turner Foundation, and Kettering Health Network, this new CCP drone program will be open for ECA students starting in the fall of 2019.

ECA is the only school in Ohio that offers dual enrollment credit for a drone program. The four-year program seeks to equip students for careers in technology and aviation. The courses will focus on the fields of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) as well as providing industry certifications for immediate workforce development in the Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) field. The coursework will expose students to UAS navigation planning, data entry, UAS security, UAS aerial photography, principles of management, and more.
