Welcome to Mile High!

Established in 1913, Mile High Academy is located in southern Denver, Colorado, the state capital and largest city in the United States Mountain West Region.

Southern Denver is an educational hub, and Mile High Academy is located close to the of University of Denver, the #82 ranked national research university in the United States.

The location of Denver gives easy access to the Rocky Mountains where many outdoor activities are available. These include hiking, biking, paddle boarding, lake sports, skiing, snowboarding, sledding, snowmobiling, 4wheeling and camping. From Mile High Academy it is 20 minutes to Downtown Denver where many great shopping locations can be found.

Mile High Academy moved to this 15-acre campus two years ago and invested over 9 million dollars in this new education center. It features two large buildings, three field locations with a soccer field, baseball field and multiple playgrounds. Inside the buildings you can find a science lab, a STEM lab, a library, music room and much more. Currently plans are underway to build an additional building which will become the High School area

There are four parts to the school: a Preschool, a Lower Elementary, a Middle School and an Upper School.

The classrooms feature smart boards, one to one laptop program.

Musical Education Program

At Mile High Academy every student has a tremendous opportunity to grow their musical and artistic abilities, and to learn new skills. A variety of ensembles and group lessons including Suzuki strings, Concert Band/Orchestra, Beginning Symphony Orchestra, Intermediate Symphony Orchestra, Upper School Symphony Orchestra, Choirs, Hand Bell Choir and Theory and Appreciation classes are available to the students.

Private lessons are also available for many instruments and the school encourages all students to take advantage of one-on-one instruction. Many of the groups participate in musical activities outside of school in the Denver area. Some have tours and specialized trips and requirements. Every student from Kindergarten through 6th grade participates in Music classes that include Hand Bell choir, rhythm and theory instruction, singing and many other fun and educational activities.

Customize Your Education

The rigorous academic program at Mile High offers 25 different courses, including 7 Advance Placement (AP Courses), Dual Credit Courses through (ADU, WWU, UC and AU) and Drawing, Graphic Design, Video Editing, Drama, Choir, Band and many other course offerings.

AP Courses include AP Calculus, AP Statistics, AP English Language & Composition, AP Environmental Science, AP English Literature, AP Psychology, AP Computer Science.

Dual Credit Classes include Honors Anatomy/Physiology, Honors Chemistry, Honors Physics, Honors Pre-Calculus.

Suzuki Strings Program

Violin, viola and cello instruction is provided in a group setting for all students from Pre-Kindergarten through 5th grade. After 5th grade each student will have the option of continuing with their string instrument of choice in the Band/Orchestra or learning a wind instrument. Teachers and parents are welcome to participate in the group lessons.

98% of graduates go on to attend colleges and universities.

Special Activities

Every year students have the opportunity to be involved in overseas trips. Classes taking British Literature and World History make trips to England & France and Spain & Italy.

All students are encouraged to join trips to other world locations where they give their time and assistance to needy communities.

School events held each year include the Pepsi Center Games where MHA Basketball teams compete with a rival school in the professional NBA arena and the Mustang Mosey 5K & 10K fun run. The school also holds many social activities for the students such as the Ice Cream Social and evening activities for students and families, such as overnight camping.

The most convenient airport is Denver International Airport (DEN).

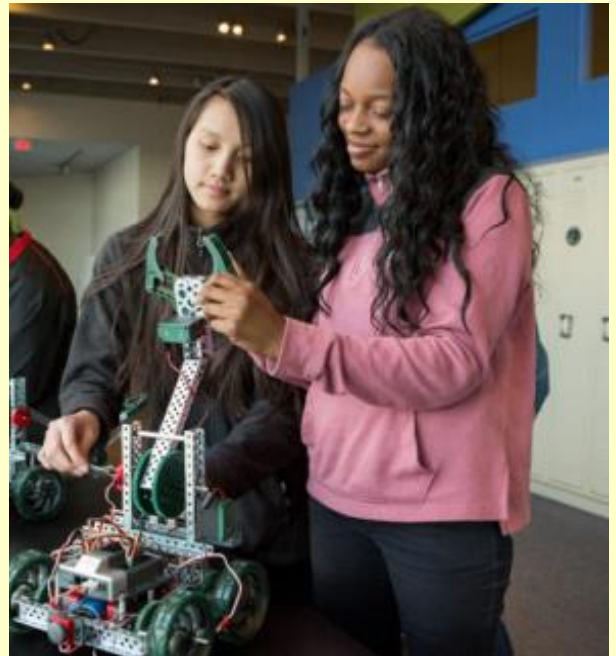


STEM PROGRAM

Mile High Academy offers all students a STEM program. This is a curriculum based on the idea of educating students in four specific disciplines – science, technology, engineering and mathematics – in an interdisciplinary and applied approach. Rather than teach the four disciplines as separate and discrete subjects, STEM integrates them into a cohesive learning paradigm based on real-world situations.

Students learn to use and manage technology through an interactive, multimedia program, while engaging in authentic problem-based learning.

High School STEM Education for grades 9-12 aligns the skills and knowledge needed to bridge the gap between secondary education and college/career success. Students develop critical thinking and collaborative problem-solving skills while utilizing real world applications.
