Richmond Academy, established in 1911, is located in Richmond, Virginia which is 158 km south of Washington, D.C.

Richmond, the capital of Virginia, is among America's oldest major cities. Patrick Henry, a U.S. Founding Father, famously declared "Give me liberty or give me death" at its St. John's Church in 1775, leading to the Revolutionary War. Richmond was the home of Confederate President Jefferson Davis during the Civil War, and his home is now a museum in Court End, a neighborhood known for Federal-style mansions.

Students in grades 3-8 use Chromebooks and Google Apps for curriculum enrichment and individual and group projects as they progress on their journey with technology. All high school students are issued MacBook Air laptops as part of our 1:1 program.

Richmond Academy offers a variety of extracurricular activities.

Field Trips – Trips taken throughout the year to places related to current studies, such as museums, historic sites and festivals.

Class Trips – Day trips for activities of student interest, such as theme parks.

Mission Trips – Trips which give students the opportunity to show Christian love in service to those who desperately need it.

Cultural Trips – Cultural exploration trips to destinations such as Europe, South America, and the 48 contiguous states.

Music Group Tour – RA's music groups occasionally go on tour in regions outside of central Virginia.

Other special features – Winter ski program, Lego robotics club, RA has launched "The Leader in Me" program in order to inspire leadership in each student.
